

School Group Pre-Visit Information

Booking a Reservation

- * Groups must book in advance to be eligible for the best available group rate.
- * Groups must consist of 15 or more guests.
- * Group visits must be pre-arranged at least five (5) days prior to your visit.

- * Upon completion of your reservation you will receive a booking confirmation for your files.

Arrival Procedures

- * Please have the group leader go to the Group Ticket window.
- * Please have the rest of your group wait at the bottom of the ramp.
- * Provide the ticket agent with your reservation confirmation form and payment.
- * The ticket booth accepts:
Company/School check
Cash
Credit Cards: Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express
Purchase Orders: Please provide ticket agent with a copy
- * The ticket booth does not accept personal checks. Please use only one form of payment.
- * Upon receiving your tickets please proceed up the ramp to the elevators.

Elevators

- * Food and drinks are not permitted on the elevators.
- * All elevators are operated by a trained Space Needle Elevator Operator.
- * Each elevator can hold up to 24 people.
- * The elevators travel at a speed of 10 mph.

Observation Deck (also known as the O Deck)

- * The Observation Deck is located 520 feet above ground.
- * SkyQ Interactive Technology consists of five (5) informative kiosks teaching about Geography, Hidden Seattle, Voices of Seattle, Time-Lapse View and Zoom Technology with a View.
- * Points of Interest Boards are posted to help compare the Space Needle with other Monuments, History and Construction of the Space Needle.
- * Tour Guides are always available to answer any questions.
- * Restrooms are located on the Observation Deck near the elevators.

Cancellations

- * As a courtesy, please call three (3) days in advance to cancel your reservation.

Rules

- * Do not throw objects over the side.
- * All guests should behave in a courteous and responsible manner at all times.
- * Behave safely and walk, do not run inside the Space Needle.
- * Eating and drinking is not allowed outside on the Observation Deck.
- * Please place all garbage in the garbage cans.
- * Be sure to follow instructions of the Space Needle staff.
- * Space Needle staff reserves the right to remove guests if their behavior is disruptive or dangerous.
- * No jumping is permitted in the elevators.
- * Please keep hands away from elevator doors when they are being opened or closed.
- * No smoking is allowed in the building or outside on the Observation Deck.
- * For any emergencies please alert the nearest Space Needle staff member.

Tips

- * Book your arrival time for 9am to avoid lines.
- * King County Metro Transit Field Trip Program is a cost effective way to travel.
- * Bring a sack lunch and eat outside by the International Fountain or inside at the Seattle Center House Food Court.
- * Book your transportation as a group on the Seattle Center Monorail and receive a group rate.
- * Book your visit to the Space Needle in conjunction with a visit to the Pacific Science Center and Experience Music Project.
