SkyQ is a one-of-a-kind interactive experience on the Space Needle Observation Deck. It consists of 5 touch-screen kiosks that feature an ever-changing kaleidoscope of “I am Seattle” insights by everyone from a ferry captain to a barista. Plus the ability to zoom in, real time, to signature places such as the Seattle Aquarium and Pike Place Market. And much more to keep students interested, involved and informed on a whole, new level.

SkyQ’s 5 interactive touch screen displays:

1 SkyQ puts the “Gee!” in Geography

Students’ hands “soar” over a regional map (with moving clouds and airplanes) as they touch the screen for details on special places by state, county, city or neighborhood.

2 Discover the hidden Seattle

A bright, fun, 360° illustrated view of Seattle and beyond beckons kids to place their hand on it. Doing so reveals hidden images as well as informative insights and facts.

3 Unique perspectives, above & below

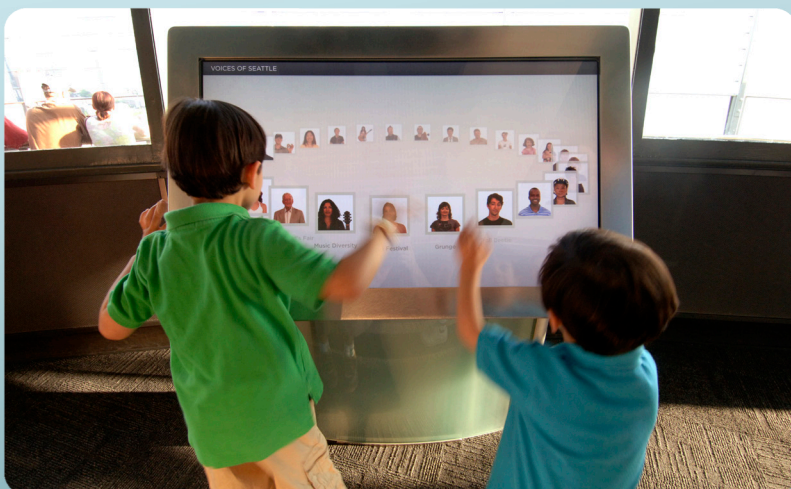

4 Experience a day in the life...

Students can rotate a dial to experience an amazingly flawless, time-lapse view of 24-hours in the life of Seattle from sunup to sundown to sunup and back (and forth).
